

THE LYNN FEIST MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

West River Health Services Foundation, in cooperation with West River Health Services, is pleased to sponsor the **LYNN FEIST MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** for Health Care Professionals and Mid-Level Practitioners.

ELIGIBILITY

- Health care professionals include nursing, respiratory therapy, occupational therapy, pharmacy, radiology technology, medical technology, etc.
- A mid-level practitioner is defined as a physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, or nurse midwife.
- Preference will be given to high school seniors from the following South Dakota schools, Lemmon, Bison, McIntosh, and Faith.
- Applicants must be admitted or accepted into the college and/or course of study of his/her chosen profession.
- Consideration will be given to an occasional scholarship for students enrolled in business or business management.

- Students must be considered "full-time" status as determined by their institution of higher learning.
- Students must maintain a grade point average of 3.0, or higher if required by the college/university for acceptance into the student's professional program.
- Students who are enrolled in health care studies may be eligible for continued loan funding their final two years of study through the West River Health Services Foundation loan program.

PROCEDURE

A completed application along with a current transcript of grades from the school in which student is presently enrolled must be submitted to the West River Health Services Foundation. **Applications are due April 1st.**

First-year college students must submit a letter of acceptance from the college/university he/she has chosen to attend.

Scholarship applications are reviewed and approved by the West River Health Services Academic Scholarship/Loan Committee.

Scholarship funding is based on eligibility of applicant, availability of funds, and the

enrollment of student in an approved curriculum.

Scholarship funds are dispersed following the first semester after having received a current transcript of grades from the college/university where student is presently enrolled.
