

# Visitors Information



## **PARKING**

Patients/Visitors may park anywhere in the parking lot except those areas clearly marked as loading zones, physician parking or "no parking" areas. If you need handicap access, please use the ER entrance or the entrance located on the south side of the hospital. Facility map available at [www.wrhs.com](http://www.wrhs.com).

## **VISTING HOURS**

OB: Significant others and family may visit anytime. Please stop at the nurses station to check with the OB nurse before entering the room.

General Visiting Hours: Visitors chosen by the patient will enjoy full and equal visitation privileges consistent with the patient's wishes.

If you have a fever with coughing or sneezing, please consider calling or emailing.

Several sanitizing stations are located throughout the medical facility.

## **TELEPHONE**

Hospital operator may be reached by dialing "0."

Local calls: Dial "9," wait for a dial tone, and then dial the number you desire.

Long distance: Dial "9," wait for a dial tone, then dial "0" and the number for a credit call card, or dial "0" to get an operator to charge the call to your home phone.

The hospital has prepaid phone cards available for purchase at the switchboard. If you have any other questions about using the phone, there are detailed instructions located in each bedside table.

## **FOOD SERVICE**

Meals for guests may be purchased for delivery to the patient room, or guests are welcome to eat in the hospital cafeteria.
